New Archery Equipment to support Visually Impaired

Thank you to the Lillie Johnson Charitable Trust who provided a £1,000 grant to purchase adaptive archery equipment to enable our visually impaired clients and students to partake in our archery clubs. Their funding has allowed us to purchase archery kit including custom made bright yellow arrows, foot locators and tactile sights. The specialist archery equipment for visually impaired users will allow them to take part in a greater range of activities at QAC, but it will also allow them to further enhance their skills set, abilities and socialise through the sport.



Community Services attract huge grant to support their work
