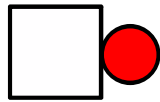

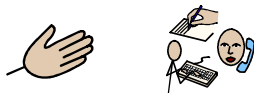

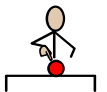

I am in the last year of my course at QAC.



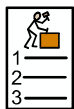
